The Household Defendants respectfully submit this Status Report in advance of the March 12, 2007 Status Conference. To Defendants' knowledge, there are no issues that require this Court's attention or consideration at this time, particularly as Magistrate Judge Nolan has established an expert discovery schedule that will run through at least August 2007. For this reason, Defendants unsuccessfully urged Plaintiffs to join in an application to adjourn the March 12, 2007 conference. For reasons they did not explain, Plaintiffs indicated their preference to have the conference proceed.

Status of Proceedings Before Magistrate Judge Nolan

Fact discovery in this matter concluded on January 31, 2007, except for several specifically authorized depositions and the resolution of certain discovery-related motions pending before Judge Nolan. In a January 24, 2007 Order, Judge Nolan established a detailed schedule and sequence for expert discovery. As amended by an Order dated February 27, 2007, expert proceedings will begin with the submission of Plaintiffs' expert reports on May 1, 2007 and conclude, after expert depositions, on or about August 1, 2007. At the last conference, on January 10, 2007, the Court indicated that Magistrate Judge Nolan should continue to supervise proceedings in this action through the completion of expert discovery and that "[a]fter that is over, we will then meet again and decide how we go from here." (Transcript of January 10, 2007 Status Conference at p. 21, a relevant excerpt of which is attached hereto.)

There are no motions or objections to rulings of Judge Nolan that are pending before this Court and Defendants are aware of no other matters that require the Court's atten-

tion at this time. Defendants nevertheless will be prepared to discuss any issues that the Court or Plaintiffs may wish to raise at the March 12 conference.
