MINUTE entry before the Honorable Ronald A. Guzman: Defendants seek leave to file briefs in support of their motions for judgment as a matter of law and a new trial that are in excess of fifteen pages; well in excess, at 68 and 132 pages, respectively. Because the Court is confident that defendants can thoroughly address their post-trial motions in far less than 200 pages, it denies their motions for leave to file over-length briefs [doc. nos. 1634 & 1637]. Defendants have until 8/3/09 to file one consolidated memorandum, no more than 65 pages long, in support of both of their post-trial motions. Plaintiffs have until 9/3/09 to file a consolidated response with the same page limit. Defendants have until 9/18/09 to file a consolidated reply not to exceed 30 pages. Plaintiffs' motions to strike defendants post-trial motions [doc. no. 1636 & 1641] are denied. Mailed notice (cjpg,)
