ORDER

PURSUANT TO STIPULATION, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- Defendant Household will preserve and maintain within the United States, until 1. the close of document discovery in this action (including the resolution of then-outstanding discovery disputes), all documents in its possession and/or under its control that are relevant to the allegations in plaintiffs' Complaint; provided, however, that this restriction shall not apply to any document that has been produced to plaintiffs by Household in connection with this litigation.
- Notwithstanding the foregoing, Household may remove any such documents from 2. the United States; provided, however, that any such documents held outside the United States shall be treated for purposes of discovery in this action as if they are held within Household's possession, custody or control within the United States. In addition, any such documents removed from the United States that are ultimately subject to production in this litigation will be produced to plaintiffs at a situs within the United States.
- 3. The term "documents," as used in the foregoing paragraphs, shall have the same meaning as is employed in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 34 and shall include writings. drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, phone records and other data compilations (including all electronically recorded or stored data) from which information can be obtained, translated, if necessary, by the respondent through detection devices into reasonably usable form.
